The sign-up board is located in the connector hallway by the Meditation Garden. If you have any questions regarding this ministry, please contact Billy Cox or Cliff Bratton.

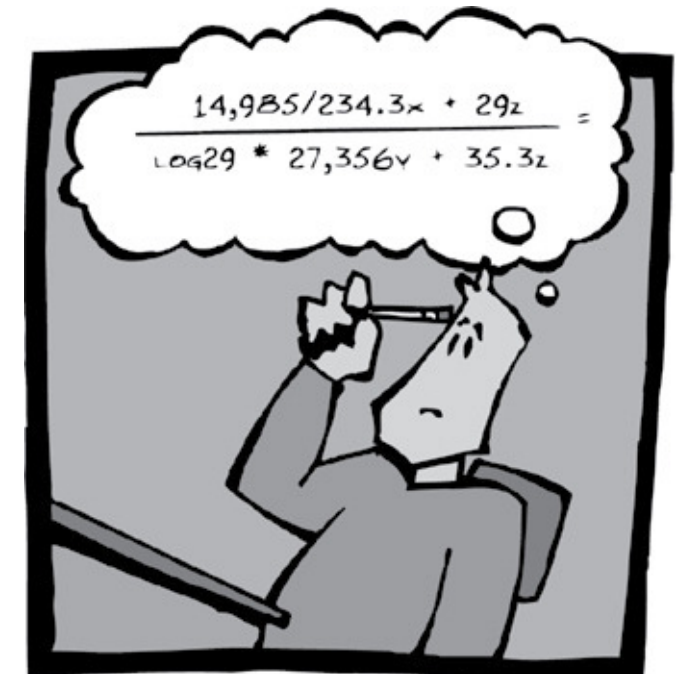
